transmission fluid

pool chemicals  
fluorescent lamps



## FROM THE YARD AND HOUSE:

poisons  
insecticides  
fungicides  
fertilizers  
weed killers  
moth balls  
flea control products  
rubber cement  
airplane glue  
fiberglass resins  
photo chemicals  
chemistry sets  
floor and metal polish  
oven cleaner  
drain and toilet cleaner  
spot remover

mercury thermometers  
thermostats  
button batteries  
batteries: rechargeable, Lithium, alkaline and Nicad

\*Products that contain mercury, such as fever thermometers and button batteries, found in watches and hearing aids, may also be brought to the collection.

Prescription and OTC Medications Over the counter and most prescription drugs will be accepted, even if they are expired. The items must be left in the original container. Scratch out name on prescription bottles.

\*The following medicines WILL NOT be accepted: Schedule 1 Narcotics For a list of schedule 1 Drugs visit:

**Electronics:** Electronic (E-Scrap) items will be accepted regardless of working condition.

**The following E-Scrap items will be accepted:** computer monitors, televisions (\$10 fee required), microwave ovens, computer CPU's, stereos, telephones, laptops, copiers, CB radios, printers, video machines, CD players, disk drives, VCR's and DVD players, portable radios, floppy drives, camcorders, cell phones, test and networking equipment, cameras, keyboards, modems, record players, scanners, circuit boards, speakers, electronic panels, typewriters, UPS / battery back-ups, fax machines, CD ROMs, projectors, cables and computer mice

The following items will not be accepted: consoles, projection televisions, vacuum cleaners, refrigerators, washers, dryers, freezers, de-humidifiers or humidifiers, gas-powered equipment, tires, household trash and NON-electronic equipment.
